Hon'ble President of India will be leading the celebrations of Constitution Day live from Central Hall of Parliament on 26th November 2021 from 11:00 am onwards. The occasion will be graced by Hon'ble Vice-President, Hon'ble Prime Minister, Hon'ble Speaker, Ministers, MPs and other dignitaries. The programme will be live streamed through Sansad TV/ DD/ Other TV Channels and online Portals.
